INSTRUCTIONS

1. Each scout should bring a properly filled out Merit Badge “Blue Card” with Unit Leader signature. He should also bring the merit badge books, pen and pencils, notebook, and any required materials for the merit badge.
2. Each scout may attend up to two Merit Badge classes. Only one Eagle Required merit badge may be taken. If the scout comes prepared with the requirements listed on the back of this form, he will have the opportunity to complete two merit badges during this event.
3. Scout uniform must be worn. Scout T-shirts are NOT acceptable.
4. Each scout troop should be accompanied and supervised by the appropriate number of adult leaders and tour permit.
5. Due to class size limitations (10 scouts per class), enrollment will be granted based on the following: First priority – Postmark of registration; Second priority – Current rank of 1st Class and above mandatory for all Eagle Required merit badges.
